Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
U. S. Deputy Surveyor T. K. Stewart,
in 1884.

From the cor. of Tps. 39 and 40 N., R. 51 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 6 ins. above ground, as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the W. bdy. of T. 39 N., R. 51 E., re-surveyed concurrently under this same group.

N. 0° 03' E., along the W. bdy. of sec. 31.

Over mountainous land, covered with medium sagebrush, buckbrush and bunchgrass; asc. 240 ft. over WSW. slope.

15.97 The E. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 27, T. 40 N., R. 50 E., hereinafter described.

Ascend 200 ft. over WSW. slope.

27.50 Top of ascent; desc. 80 ft. over WNW. slope.

39.75 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 6 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
