

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 38 N., R. 45 E.

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The portion of Township 38 North, Range 45 East, included in this survey is located approximately 6 miles southwest of Midas, Nevada. The elevations range from about 4,600 ft. to 6,000 ft. above sea level. The soil consists of sandy clay at the lower elevations and rocky clay at the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale and native grasses on the portions of the township not under cultivation.

There are 3 ranches located in the area, all of which are situated along Evans Creek. Evans Creek enters the township 3.80 chs. E. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36 on the N. boundary of the township, and flows in a southwesterly direction, leaving the township through the W. boundary of sec. 30.

Access to the township is provided by Nevada State Route No. 18, which enters the township on the W. boundary of sec. 19 and leaves on the N. boundary of sec. 1.

Drainage is from the NW. and SE. to Evans Creek. There were no mining activities of any consequence noted.
