10.00 Bottom of descent; over low rolling hills.

27.30 Draw, drains SSW.

39.10 Draw, drains SW.

41.20 The $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

N. 1° 35' E., beginning new measurement.

Over rolling land; asc. 30 ft. over a SE. slope.

5.20 Trail road, parallels gas pipeline.

5.40 Natural gas pipeline, underground, bears N. 34° E. and S. 34° W.; asc. 70 ft. over a SE. slope.
