	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The land within Township 37 North, Range 37 East, is mountainous in the eastern portion, rolling in the southern portion, nearly level in the central portion, and sand dunes in the north and west portions. The elevations range from 4,300 ft. to 5,600 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy in the lower elevations to sandy loam in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and sparse bunchgrass.</p> <p>There are windmills located in sections 8 and 20.</p> <p>Principal users of the township are cattlemen and the sand dunes portion is used by the four wheel drive and dune buggy club, from Winnemucca, for recreation. Access into the township is provided by trail roads.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted at the time of this survey.</p>
