N. 0° 16' W., bet. secs. 10 and 11.

Over nearly level land, through medium sagebrush and cheatgrass.

40.09 Point for the  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor. of secs. 10 and 11, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

66.20 Ravine, drains E, changing to ENE.

80.18 Point for the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

set a steel fence post,  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. in the ground, alongside the iron post.

From this corner, the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an unmarked willow post, firmly set in a mound of earth, with a steel rod,  $\frac{1}{2}$ x36 ins., alongside the willow post, with a metal tag mkd. RLS 626 1 6 7 12, bears S. 89° 16' E., (mean bearing) 163.08 chs. dist. This is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. There is no remaining evidence of the intervening original corners.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
