41.04	<p>N. 0° 07' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.</p> <p>Over gently rolling W. slope; through scattered sagebrush and greasewood.</p> <p>The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with the remains of a badly decayed wooden post, loosely set in a small mound of earth.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T21N R39E R40E S 1 S 6 1970</p> <p>reset the remains of the wooden post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, W. of cor.</p>
