40.65	<p>S. 89° 39' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.</p> <p>Over low rolling hills, through medium dense sagebrush; asc. 120 ft. over E. slope.</p> <p>The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, monumented with a badly deteriorated cedar post, loosely set in a small mound of earth.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T22N R39E S 36 ¼ S 1 T21N</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1970</p> <p>reset the remains of the cedar post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.</p> <hr style="width: 20%; margin: 10px auto;"/> <p>S. 80° 52' W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over low rolling hills, through medium sagebrush; asc. 60 ft. over E. slope.</p> <p>8.00 Slope changes to N.; asc. 40 ft. to top of ridge.</p> <p>18.20 Head of draw, drains NE.</p> <p>22.10 Low ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 50 ft. over W. slope.</p> <p>27.50 Ravine, drains S.; asc. 70 ft. over E. slope.</p> <p>32.80 Low ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 70 ft. over W. slope.</p>
