

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,  
T. 21 N., R. 39 E.

CHAINS	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	<p>Township 21 North, Range 39 East is located in Edwards Creek Valley. The elevations range from about 5,100 ft. to 5,800 ft. above sea level. General drainage is to the southwest. The soil ranges from sandy to sandy clay on the valley floor, to rocky and sandy clay in the higher elevations. Vegetation consists of greasewood, sagebrush and shadscale.</p> <p>The west <math>\frac{1}{2}</math> of sec. 11 and the west <math>\frac{1}{2}</math> of sec. 23 are under cultivation. The remainder of the township is used for grazing purposes. No mining activity was noticed.</p> <p>Access to the township is provided by two graded roads and numerous trail roads.</p>
