Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
S. T. Morse, U. S. Compassman, under
T. H. Lowe's Contract
in 1902.

The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, Tps. 1 and 2 S.,
Rs. 69 E., monumented with the decayed remains of the
original wooden post, loosely set in a small mound of
stone.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

reset the remains of the original wooden post and set a
steel fence post, 6 ft. long, alongside the iron post
and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high,
W. of cor.

N. $89^{\circ} 45'$ W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over gently rolling land, covered with sagebrush and
scattered juniper.

- 0.60 Wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains N.
- 2.00 Fence, bears SE. and NW.
- 5.40 Trail road, bears SE. and NW.; asc. 20 ft. over NE. slope.
- 39.94 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at propor-
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the
original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
