This Independent Resurvey Supersedes the Survey Executed by Preble and Thorburn, U. S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1882. A diligent search was made for the original corners and none were found.

From the standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over rolling land, through scattered timber and undergrowth; asc. 20 ft. over S. slope.

16.00 Low ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 120 ft. over N. slope.

37.70 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains E.; asc. 20 ft. over S. slope.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

77.90 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains E.; asc. 20 ft. over S. slope.

80.00 Point for the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
