## INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES OF

T. 26 N., R. 69 E. CHAINS GENERAL DESCRIPTION The land within Township 26 North, Range 69 East, varies from about 5,800 to 6,500 ft. above sea level. The terrain is rolling to hilly draining easterly by numerous dry washes. The soil is a sandy clay, gravel and rocky. The vegetation is mostly sagebrush and greasewood. There are scattered juniper trees on the higher elevations of little commercial value. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey. Principal use of the township is grazing for livestock. Access into the area is provided by numerous desert trail roads. There are no residents in the township.
