45.20	Wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains SSE.; asc. 220 ft. over an E. slope.
65.00	Spur, slopes SSE.; desc. 350 ft. over a W. slope.
78.75	The cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the W. bdy. of T. 27 N., R. 69 E., executed under Group No. 463, in 1969. Land, rolling. Soil, sandy clay and gravel. Timber, none. Undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.
	From the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18. N. 0° 04' W., bet. secs. 7 and 8. Over rolling hills, through scattered timber and undergrowth.
34.50	Spur, slopes E.; desc. 70 ft. over a NE. slope.
40.00	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 8. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T27N R69E ½ S 7 S 8 1971 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor. from this corner A pinon, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 87½° E., 31 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S8 BT. A juniper, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 58½° W., 19 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S7 BT. Desc. 30 ft. over a NE. slope.
44.10	Ravine, drains SE.; asc. 90 ft. over a S. slope.
55.00	Spur, slopes W.; desc. 190 ft. over a N. slope.
72.20	Ravine, drains NE.; asc. 60 ft. over a SE. slope.
80.00	Point for the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.
