

## RETRACEMENT OF A PORTION OF THE NEVADA-UTAH STATE LINE

CHAINS

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Retracement of the Survey Executed by I. E. James, U. S. Astronomer and Surveyor, in 1870, and resurveyed between Mile Post Nos. 86 and 87, in 1918 by U. S. Surveyor Marshall S. Wright, under Group No. 53, Nevada.

Beginning at Mile Post No. 81, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

S. 0° 08' E., along the 82nd mile.

Over nearly level land, through scattered undergrowth.

- 6.40 Bladed road, bears E. and W.
- 12.90 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains E.
- 16.88 The closing corner of secs. 1 and 12, T. 8 S., R. 20 W., SIM., Utah, monumented with a limestone, 6x4 ins., showing 4 ins. above ground and plainly mkd. with CC on the east face, no other marks visible, bears WEST, 0.05 chs. dist.
- 19.16 The E. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 2, T. 26 N., R. 70 E., hereinafter described.
- 59.16 The closing corner of secs. 2 and 11, T. 26 N., R. 70 E., hereinafter described.
- 61.00 Spur, slopes NE.
- 80.09 Mile Post No. 82, monumented with a cedar post, 32 ins. long, 3 ins. square, dimly mkd. with illegible scribing and firmly set in a mound of earth with a stone mkd. X, at the base of post.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- reset the wooden post and marked stone alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.
- Land, nearly level.  
Soil, sandy clay and gravel.  
Undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.
