21.01	The closing corner of Tps. 8 and 9 S., R. 20 E., SLM., Utah, monumented with a basalt stone, 8x12x12 ins., firmly set in the ground and plainly mkd. with CC on the E. face and 6 notches on the N. edge and 6 notches on the S. edge, bears WEST, 0.09 chs. dist.
30.50	Bladed road, bears WNW. and ESE.
39.20	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains NE.
59.40	Wash, 15 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains ENE.
62.14	The standard closing corner of Tps. 25 and 26 N., R. 70 E., hereinafter described. The standard closing corner of Tps. 25 and 26 N., R. 70 E., of the 1918 dependent resurvey, which now functions as an amended monument, bears S. 89° 23' E., 30 lks. dist.
80.28	<p>Mile Post No. 87, monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., showing 14 ins. above ground, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.</p> <p>Land, rolling. Soil, sandy clay and gravel. Timber, juniper. Undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.</p>

<p>Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by Preble and Thorburn, U. S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1881, and Resurveyed by U. S. Surveyor M. S. Wright, in 1918.</p>	
<p>The 1918 standard corner monuments are described herein and will now serve as Angle Points. New standard corners are established at intervals of 40 chs. in Easting from the 1971 standard cor. of Tps. 26 N., Rs. 69 and 70 E.</p>	
<p>From the standard cor. of Tps. 26 N., Rs. 69 and 70 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the Fifth Standard Parallel North, through R. 69 E., surveyed concurrently under this same group.</p>	
<p>N. 89° 56' E., along the S. bdy. of sec. 31.</p>	
<p>Over rolling land, through scattered timber and undergrowth.</p>	
12.80	Wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains ENE.
