	The land within Township 28 North, Range 70 East, ranges from about 4,800 to 6,200 ft. above sea level, and is nearly level to rolling. The soil is sandy clay, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood and Indian ricegrass. There is scattered timber on the higher elevations.
	There are numerous washes and gulches throughout the township, all of which are dry and drains northeasterly into the salt flats. There is no water in the township.
	No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
	Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by numerous desert trail roads.
