39.48	<p>The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, monumented with a granite stone, 18x12x6 ins., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face and firmly set in a mound of stone.</p>
	<p>At the corner point</p>
	<p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>
	<p>T34N R39E</p>
	<p>S $3\frac{1}{4}$ S 2</p>

	<p>Over mountainous land, through sagebrush and bunchgrass; asc. 70 ft. along a W. slope.</p>
10.00	<p>Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 190 ft. over a NE. slope.</p>
35.00	<p>Ravine, drains NNW.; enter dense aspen and juniper; desc. 120 ft. over a NW. slope.</p>
39.95	<p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p>
