From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy.  
of the Tp.

N. 11° 59' E., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth;  
desc. slightly over NE. slope.

2.20 Draw, drains SE.

10.60 Creek, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course ESE.

31.20 Trail road, bears ESE. and WNW.; desc. 30 ft. along  
E. slope.

44.44 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with a  
granite stone, 10x8x6 ins., plainly mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the W.  
face, firmly set in a mound of stone.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 14 ins.  
in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone,  
2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

4.40 Draw, drains E.; asc. 70 ft. along E. slope.

20.30 Draw, drains E.; asc. 30 ft. along E. slope.
