0.30	Telephone line, bears N. 60½° E. and S. 60½° W.
2.30	Fence, bears S. 16° E. and N. 16° W.
8.90	Trail road, bears ENE. and WSW.
40.00	Creek, 2 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course SE.
40.85	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 24, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
