The cor. of Tps. 36 and 37 N., Rs. 46 and 47 E., monumented with the decayed remains of a square willow post, 14 ins. long, 1 in. square, dimly scribed and loosely set in a mound of earth.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

The cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a granite stone, 12x8x6 ins., plainly mkd. with 2 notches on the S. face and 4 notches on the N. face and firmly set in the ground, with a small mound of stone to the W.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
