GENERAL DESCRIPTION	
<p>The land within Township 36 North, Range 46 East, ranges from about 5,000 to 6,600 ft. above sea level, and is nearly level to rolling and mountainous. The soil is sandy clay, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, rabbitbrush and native grass.</p> <p>The township is drained by Rock Creek, which winds south through the eastern portion of the township.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by desert trail roads throughout the township.</p>
