Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by  
Hatch, Eaton and Smyles, U.S. Deputy Surveyors,  
in 1872

Beginning at the cor. of Tps. 36 and 37 N., Rs. 47 and  
48 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set,  
mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

S. 88° 40' W., bet. sec. 1 and 36.

Over rolling land, through medium sagebrush.

- 2.10 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains S.
- 16.60 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SSE.
- 35.40 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains S.
- 40.45 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, at propor-  
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the  
original corner.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in  
the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- 80.90 Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, at propor-  
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of  
the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in  
the ground, with brass cap mkd.
