From the standard cor. of Tps. 46 N., Rs. 55 and 56 E.,
monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd.
and witnessed as described in the field notes of the
concurrent dependent resurvey of a portion of the Ninth
Standard Parallel North, through Range 56 East, executed
under this same group.

S. 89° 53' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 36.

Over mountainous land, through medium sagebrush and
native grass; asc. 340 ft. over broken NE. slope.

12.68 The closing cor. of Tps. 45 N., Rs. 55 and 56 E., monu-
mented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and
exposed 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.
