(Ruby Valley Guide Meridian), monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent dependent resurvey of the West boundary of T. 46 N., R. 56 E., executed under this same group.</p> <p>S. 89° 59' W., bet. secs. 25 and 36.</p> <p>Over mountainous land; asc. gradually over meadow.</p> <p>2.00 Small wash, drains NE.; leave meadow; enter medium sagebrush and native grass; asc. 40 ft. over E. slope.</p> <p>4.00 Fence, bears NE. and SW.; asc. 120 ft. along S. slope.</p> <p>19.79 Point for the E. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 26, at proportionate distance.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>
