<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p>	
<p>The area resurveyed within Township 47 North, Range 55 East is mountainous, and the major portion of the area is contained within the McDonald Creek canyon. The elevation ranges from about 5,200 ft. to 6,900 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy loam along the bottom of McDonald Creek canyon, to extremely rocky and clay in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale and native grasses throughout the area. The south side of McDonald Creek canyon is covered with scattered to dense pinon, juniper, aspen and mahogany. The bottoms of the major drainages are covered with dense aspen, willows and wild roses.</p> <p>McDonald Creek crosses the area in a northeasterly course. The water in McDonald Creek is used for irrigation of meadows along the bottom of the canyon, which are used for production of hay and pasture.</p> <p>No mining activity was noted in the area resurveyed.</p>
