The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with a basalt stone, 12x10x4 ins., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face and firmly set in the ground.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

The cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a granite stone, 24x11x7 ins., mkd. with 4 notches on the S. edge and 2 notches on the N. edge, firmly set in the ground, with a mound of stone W. of cor.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
