	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area resurveyed within Township 46 North, Range 56 East is mountainous and the elevation varies from about 5,000 to 7,000 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy loam along the Bruneau River and creek bottoms to extremely rocky in the higher elevations.</p> <p>The Bruneau River enters the township at the SE. corner and flows northwesterly, leaving the township just east of the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 32 on the N. bdy. of the Tp. Meadow Creek enters the township at the S. bdy. of sec. 31, flows northwesterly, leaves the township on the W. bdy. of sec. 30, re-enters on the W. bdy. of sec. 19, flows northeasterly, connecting with the Bruneau River near the N. bdy. of sec. 5. There are numerous other small creeks and spring branches throughout the township.</p> <p>Access to the township is provided by a graded road along Meadow Creek, a bladed road along the Bruneau River, and several trail roads throughout the township.</p> <p>There was no mining activity of consequence noted in the area. Principal use of the area is for grazing. The river and creek bottoms are used for the production of hay. There is no timber of any consequence in the area.</p>
