Soil, sandy clay and gravel. Timber, none. Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood and bunchgrass.</p>
	<p>The point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1 is on the Sixth Standard Parallel North and at midpoint in departure on the N. bdy. of sec. 1.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 T30N R69E 1971 </p> <p>raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.</p> <p>from this corner</p> <p>The standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 31 N., R. 69 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the dependent resurvey of the Sixth Standard Parallel North, through R. 69 E., dependently resurveyed under this same group, bears S. $88^{\circ} 35'$ E., 12.195 chs. dist.</p>
12.50	<p>From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the north bdy. of T. 29 N., R. 69 E., executed under Group No. 463, in 1969 and 1970.</p> <p>N. $0^{\circ} 02'$ W., bet. secs. 34 and 35.</p> <p>Over rolling land, through scattered timber and undergrowth; asc. 120 ft. over SE. slope.</p> <p>Ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 190 ft. over NW. slope.</p>
