The standard ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 32, T. 31 N., R. 69 E., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the Sixth Standard Parallel North, through R. 69 E., resurveyed under this same group, bears S. 88° 36' E., 12.36 chs. dist.

The point for the N. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 4 is on the Sixth Standard Parallel North and at midpoint in departure on the N. bdy. of sec. 4.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
