The letters AM were added to the corner
stone.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land in Township 30 North, Range 69 East varies from rolling to mountainous. The elevation ranges from about 5,000 to 7,700 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay and gravelly to rocky. The vegetation consists of scattered to medium juniper and pinon with a medium undergrowth of sagebrush, greasewood and bunchgrass.

An abandoned mining operation is located in secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29. No other mining activity was noted. Tract 37 is located in secs. 33 and 34. The Ferguson Maintenance Station is located in sec. 34. No other permanent inhabitants were noted.

Alternate U. S. Highway No. 50 runs southwesterly through the township. Other access to the area is provided by several bladed roads and trail roads.
