

RETRACEMENT OF A PORTION OF THE NEVADA-UTAH STATE LINE

CHAINS	
12.05	The closing corner of secs. 30 and 31, T. 4 S., R. 19 W., SLM, Utah, monumented with a basalt stone, showing 14 ins. above ground, plainly mkd. CC on E. face, N on W. face, 1 notch on the S. edge and 5 notches on the N. edge and firmly set in a mound of earth.
16.15	The E. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 26, T. 30 N., R. 70 E., hereinafter described.
30.32	The original witness point, monumented with a porphyry stone, 36x12x12 ins., plainly mkd. with LW 37 UTAH on the E. face and LW 30 NEV on the W. face and firmly set in a mound of stone. Cor. sets on summit of ridge bearing NE. and SW. Not remonumented.
11.00	S. 0° 01' E., beginning new measurement. Over mountainous land, through scattered undergrowth; desc. 70 ft. over S. slope. Draw, drains W.; asc. 130 ft. over N. slope to spur.
25.86	The closing corner of secs. 26 and 35, T. 30 N., R. 70 E., hereinafter described.
37.50	Spur, slopes W.; desc. 130 ft. over SSE. slope.
46.00	Draw, drains W.; asc. 50 ft. over NW. slope.
50.24	Mile Post No. 62, monumented with an iron post, 2$\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the retracement of a portion of the Nevada-Utah State Line executed under Group No. 463, Nevada, in 1970. Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy clay and rocky. Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood and bunchgrass.
	INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE WEST BOUNDARY, T. 30 N., R. 70 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA
	This Independent Resurvey Supersedes the Survey Executed by Preble and Thorburn, U. S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1881. A diligent search was made for the original corners and none were found. From the cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 N., Rs. 69 and 70 E., monumented with an iron post, 2$\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the north boundary of T. 29 N., R. 69 E., executed under Group No. 463, in 1969. NORTH, bet. secs. 31 and 36.
