	This Independent Resurvey Supersedes the Survey Executed by Preble and Thorburn, U. S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1882. A diligent search was made for the original corners and none were found.
	From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the north boundary of T. 29 N., R. 70 E., executed under Group No. 463, in 1970.
	N. 0° 01' E., bet. secs. 31 and 32.
	Over rolling land, through scattered undergrowth.
37.80	Wash, 40 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains SE.
40.00	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 5 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

	Ascend 50 ft. over SE. slope to the sec. cor.
70.70	Wash, 30 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SE.
80.00	Point for the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 5 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
