	from this corner The standard cor. of Tps. 31 N., Rs. 69 and 70 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the Sixth Standard Parallel North, through R. 69 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same group, bears S. 88° 37' E., 12.22 chs. dist.	
40.00	From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the north boundary of T. 29 N., R. 70 E., executed under Group No. 463, in 1970. N. 0° 02' E., bet. secs. 32 and 33. Over rolling land, through scattered undergrowth; asc. 50 ft. over S. slope. Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T30N R70E ¼ S 32 S 33 1971 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor. Ascend 120 ft. over SE. slope.	
80.00	Point for the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T30N R70E S 29 S 28 S 32 S 33 1971 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor. Land, rolling. Soil, sandy clay and gravel. Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood and bunchgrass.
