R. 70 E., resurveyed concurrently under this
same group, bears S. $88^{\circ} 40'$ E., 12.37 chs. dist.

Land, gently rolling.

Soil, sandy clay and gravel.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood and bunchgrass.

Point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 3, on the Sixth
Standard Parallel North and at midpoint on the N. bdy. of
sec. 3.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 30 North, Range 70 East, ranges
from about 4,100 to 5,600 ft. above sea level, and is
nearly level to mountainous. The soil is sandy clay,
gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sage-
brush, greasewood, bunchgrass and some saltgrass in the
northeast portion of sec. 2. There is no timber in the
township.

There are numerous washes and gulches throughout the
township, all of which are dry and drain northeasterly
into the salt flats. The only water in the township is
small lakes located in the northeast corner of sec. 2.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during
the survey.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into
the township is by numerous desert trail roads.
