GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 34 North, Range 42 East is situated about 3 miles West of Valmy, Nevada. The elevation varies from about 6,200 to 4,400 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from rocky in the mountains to sandy clay in the lower elevations of the township. Vegetation consists of shadscale, greasewood, sagebrush and bunchgrass.

Interstate Highway No. 80 crosses through secs. 1, 2 and 12. Further access to the township is provided by numerous secondary and desert trail roads. There are 3 springs and a cabin located near the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12. The township drains generally in a NNE. direction.

A power line enters the township on the E. bdy. of sec. 36 and leaves the township on the W. bdy. of sec. 6.

There has been mining activity in the mountainous portion of the township. Principal users of the township are cattlemen.
