Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by  
U. S. Deputy Surveyor A. J. Hatch,  
in 1868.

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the N. bdy.  
of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam.,  
set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes  
of the dependent resurvey of T. 35 N., R. 43 E., executed  
under Group No. 472 in 1970.

S. 89° 45' W., bet. secs. 3 and 34.

Over nearly level land, through greasewood.

- 4.80 Fence, parallel to railroad.
- 5.00 Trail road, parallel to railroad.
- 7.10 Western Pacific Railroad, on curve, bears SE. and NW.
- 7.90 Telephone line, parallel to railroad.
- 8.90 Fence, parallel to railroad.
- 39.80 Trail road, bears SE. and NW.
- 39.87 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 34, at propor-  
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the  
original corner.
- NOT REMONUMENTED
- 48.00 Slough, 1.50 chs. wide, 4 ft. deep, bears NE. and SW.
- 65.00 Slough, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, bears NE. and SW.
- 69.50 Slough, 1.20 chs. wide, 4 ft. deep, bears N. and S.
- 79.74 Point for the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, at propor-  
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the  
original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
