N. 0° 18' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over nearly level land, through budsage and shadscale.

17.90 Ditch, 5 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains N. 70° E.

40.26 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to underlying rock and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

47.40 Trail road, bears E. and W.

50.20 Gravel road, bears N. 78° E. and S. 78° W.

80.62 The cor. of Tps. 3 and 4 N., Rs. 52 and 53 E., monumented with a granite stone, 5x4x4 ins., mkd. with 6 grooves on the N., E. and S. faces and firmly set in a mound of stone, with a steel fence post alongside.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
