Over nearly level land, through budsage.

40.00 Point for the S. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 4 N., R. 52 E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
