

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 3 N., R. 52 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed within Township 3 North, Range 52 East, ranges from about 4,950 to 5,850 ft. above sea level. The east portion is nearly level and the west portion is gently rolling to mountainous.

The soil consists of sand and gravel in the lower elevations and rocky clay in the higher elevations.

The vegetation consists of greasewood, shadscale, bud-sage and sagebrush.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access to and through the township is provided by State Highway No. 25 which crosses from N. to S. Additional access in the township is provided by improved and desert trail roads.
