diam., firmly set and exposed 6 ins. above ground, with
a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.,
with brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
