From the cor. of Tps. 2 and 3 N., Rs. 53 and 54 E.

N. 0° 03' W., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Along a gradual W. slope, through budsage and shadscale.

2.90 Graded road, bears S. 60° E. and N. 60° W.

29.50 Wash, 50 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains NW.

40.41 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Over rolling land, through budsage and shadscale; asc. 20 ft. along a W. slope, changing to a S. slope.

44.00 Spur, slopes S. 80° W. in saddle bearing N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.; desc. 20 ft. over a NW. slope.

48.00 Ravine, drains S. 65° W., approximately 2 chs. dist., thence NW.; asc. 70 ft. over a SW. slope.

54.00 Spur, slopes W., thence along a W. slope.

57.20 Spur, slopes W., changing to NW.; desc. 70 ft. over a NNW. slope.

61.30 Bottom of descent; thence along a gradual W. slope.

80.82 The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, monumented with a granite stone, 14x10x6 ins., mkd. with 1 groove on the S. face and 5 grooves on the N. face and firmly set in a mound of stone.
