The cor. of Tps. 3 and 4 N., Rs. 53 and 54 E., monumented concurrently in the resurvey of T. 4 N., R. 54 E., under this same group with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above ground, with a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor., with brass cap mkd.
