	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area resurveyed within Township 3 North, Range 53 East, ranges from about 4,950 to 5,250 ft. above sea level and is nearly level land.</p> <p>The soil is sandy and gravelly in the lower elevations and a rocky clay in the higher elevations.</p> <p>The vegetation consists of budsage and shadscale.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access to and through the township is provided by a graded road which crosses from NW. to SE. Additional access in the township is provided by desert trail roads.</p> <p>A well is located in section 35.</p>
