and partially retraced by Andrew Nelson,
U. S. Cadastral Engineer,
in 1929.

The cor. of Tps. 4 and 5 N., R. 54 E., monumented with a granite stone, 18x16x8 ins., mkd. with 6 grooves on the S. and W. faces and 6 notches on top of the stone, firmly set 12 ins. in the ground with glass and iron deposited around cor., with a mound of stone E. of cor. (This monument was set by Andrew Nelson in 1929.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
