
DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,

Cor. No. 8 of M.S. 4469, Taft lode, monumented with the remains of a pine post in a mound of stone, bears N. 11° 20' W., 5.19 chs. dist.

At the corner point

Set an iron pipe, 1 in. diam., in a drill hole, with brass tablet secured to the top and mkd.



raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, SE. of cor.

Ascend 20 ft. over W. slope.

Cor. No. 1 of M.S. 4262, Banner lode, identical with Cor. No. 4 of M.S. 4262, Roosevelt lode, determined at record bearing and distance from the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36; falls near the center of U.S. Highway No. 95:

The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, heretofore described, bears N. 15° 51' 40" W., 12.947 chs. dist.

At the corner point

Set a copper-coated steel stake, 24 ins. long, ½ in. diam., flush with pavement, with brass cap mkd.
