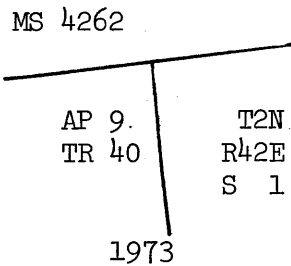


SURVEY OF TRACT 40

CHAINS



Thence S. 72° 36' W., bet. M.S. 4262, Keystone lode, and Tract 40.

4.36 Angle Point No. 10, Tract 40, identical with Cor. No. 4 of M.S. 4262, Keystone lode, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., heretofore described.

Thence N. 2° 20' E., bet. M.S. 4262, Keystone lode, and Tract 40, through housing development.

9.51 Angle Point No. 1, Tract 40, identical with Angle Point No. 10, Tract 38, and place of beginning; also North end of housing development.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed within Township 2 North, Range 42 East, varies from mountainous to rolling hills. The elevation ranges from about 6,000 to 7,200 ft. above sea level.

A portion of Tonopah, Nevada, lies in the northern portion of Section 2. There are numerous mineral surveys located in the northern portion of Sections 1 and 2.

Access is provided by U. S. Highways No. 6 and 95, paved streets and numerous gravel and trail roads.

Vegetation in the area consists of budsage, shadscale and rabbitbrush.
