firmly set in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to cap, with
brass cap mkd.

N. 0° 59' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over mountainous land, through scattered juniper, pinon
and sagebrush; desc. 200 ft. over NE. slope.

26.60 Bladed road, bears NNW. and SSE.

28.80 Trail road, bears NNW. and SSE.; along rolling E. slope.

40.34 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at propor-
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the
original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
