

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE NORTH BOUNDARY,  
T. 16 N.; R. 62 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 16 North, Range 62 East, is mountainous in the eastern portion and rolling in the western portion. The elevation ranges from about 6,800 to 7,200 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay in the lower elevations to sandy clay and rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and greasewood; the timber is juniper, pinon and mahogany.

U. S. Highway No. 50 enters the township on the north boundary of sec. 2.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted at the time of this survey.

Access into the township is provided by U. S. Highway No. 50 and desert trail roads.
