

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 12 N., R. 62 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 12 North, Range 62 East, varies from nearly level in the western portion to rolling and mountainous in the eastern portion. The elevation ranges from about 6,000 to 7,400 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy to sandy clay and rocky. The south-central and western portion of the township is under cultivation and the remaining area has vegetation consisting of sagebrush, greasewood and sparse native grasses. Timber is juniper and pinon.

The town of Lund is located in section 33.

The area drains in a westerly direction by numerous small dry washes. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Access into the area is provided by State Highway No. 38, crossing the township in a southeasterly direction and numerous desert and trail roads. Principal uses of the area are ranching and farming.
