20.40	South end of ridge, bears N.; along ridge top.
27.70	North end of ridge; desc. 150 ft. over N. slope.
40.38	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to cap, with brass cap mkd.

	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., on solid rock over a cross (X) and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to cap, with brass cap mkd.

40.38	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
