	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	<p>The land within Township 13 North, Range 62 East, varies from nearly level in the west portion, to rolling and mountainous in the east portion. The elevation ranges from about 6,000 ft. to 7,400 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay on the lower elevations to gravelly and rocky on the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood and crested wheatgrass with scattered pinon and juniper on the higher elevation. The township is drained by Water Canyon Creek which winds southwesterly through the township, entering in section 13 and leaving in section 33.</p>
	<p>There is a reseeded area in the northeastern portion of the township. A well and pump is located in section 10. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p>
	<p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by numerous trail roads.</p>
